

Edward G. Halliburton Scholarship Application

Applicant Eligibility

Any high school senior may apply who (or whose parent/guardian):

- Has been an Electro Savings Credit Union member for at least one year prior to the scholarship entry deadline (the last business day of February)
- Is enrolled at a two- or four-year college/university or accredited trade school for fall

Selection Criteria

All eligible applicants will be considered by the Electro Savings Credit Union Scholarship Committee, which will be determined by the Electro Savings Credit Union Board of Directors. Selection criteria involves a balanced combination of:

- Academic achievement
- Demonstration of school and community involvement
- An essay written by the applicant
- A letter of reference

Scholarship Details

- Electro Savings Credit Union will award three \$1,000 scholarships
- The selected recipients will be notified prior to May 31
- Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the college, university or accredited trade school
- All scholarship applications, essays and reference letters should be postmarked the last day of February or delivered by close of business the last business day of February
